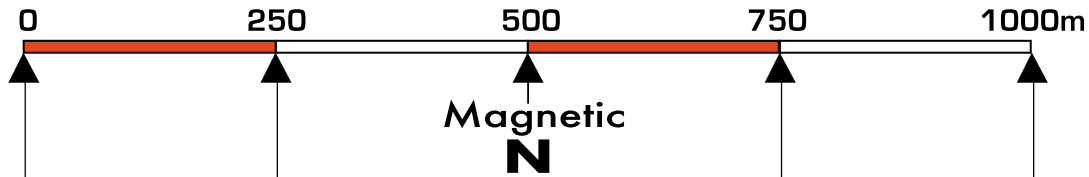


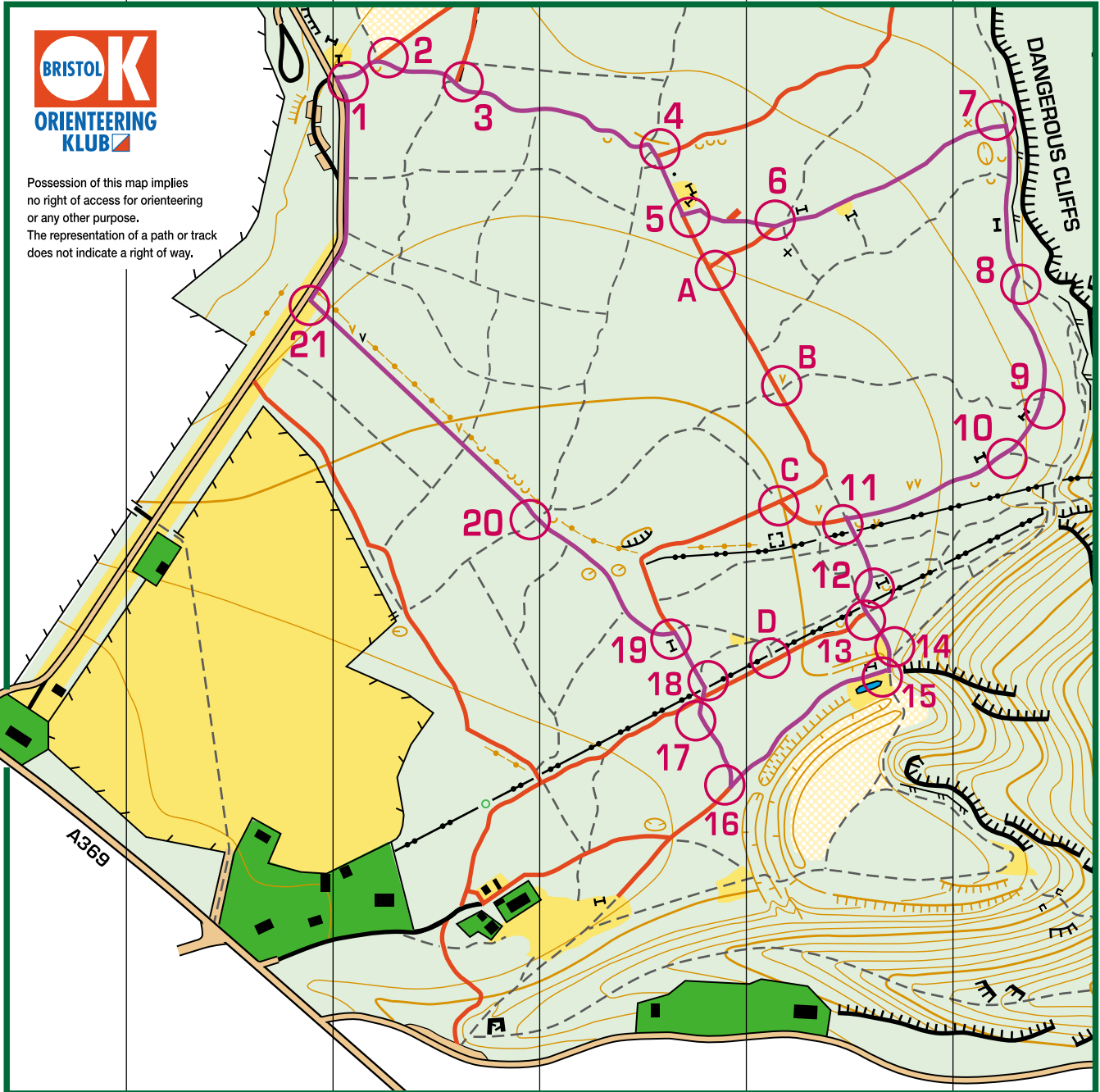
# LEIGH WOODS SPECIAL ORIENTEERING MAP
